Very Cork, July 14.—Today's cotton market was quiet at best with no striking features, but it looked as it all of the bearish factors in the situation had been well threshed out and that the market was in better position to respond to any definitely bullish developments. Prospective bulls, however, were restrained partially by uncertainty as to the outcome of pending legislation at Washington and by the fear that timely showers in the southwest would so accelerate crop developments as to make up for the late start. The Times Democrat is typical of the private reports now coming to hand from the beit at large. It stated that the condition of the crop as a whole was excelent with possibilities of a bumper yield in the event of seasonable weather over the next fortnight, but that there was also a possibility of sensational deterioration should the hot spell prove to be of abnormal duration possibility, together with the lateness of the crop and the rapid decrease in local stocks are causing some very shrewd operators to watch closely for an opportunity to buy contracts.
