[To the Associated Press.] New York, Sept. 17, p. m. The President-to-day ordered three vessels of war to New Orleans.

Gen. McDowell has been ordered to New Orleans, and Federal troops, numbering a total of about 5,000 are concentrating there.

It is believed in official quarters that the withdrawal of the Federal troops for strategic purposes are widespread in the South, and more serious than they suppose, and require prompt attention, especially in Louisiana.
