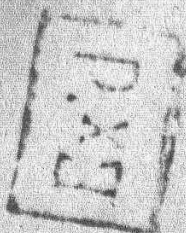

Sir,-

Referring to your letter of the 19th ultimo with which you forwarded plan, specifications and tenders for grading and filling the approaches of bridge No.3 over McKenzie Creek, between lots 24 and 25, Con.2, Tuscarora, I beg to inform you that an Order in Council has been passed dated the 22nd instant authorizing the expenditure of \$275.00 from the capital funds of the Six Nations Indians and that the work be awarded to Mr. Mathew Claus for the said sum, that being the amount of his tender. You may accordingly award the contract for the said work to Mr. Mathew Claus.

The specifications should be amended in the 4th paragraph entitled "cuttings" by adding ^{to} the said paragraph "The sides of cuttings to have slopes of $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 1".
