

XIX.

It is provided and agreed, That this present Treaty shall not in any wise derogate from the Treaty concluded between the said most Serene Kings at *Breda* the  $\frac{21}{31}$  day of *July*, in the year of our Lord 1667. But that all and singular the Articles and Clauses of that Treaty shall remain in force and be observed.

XX.

That all Treaties or Articles at any time heretofore made and concluded between the said Nations, upon the Island of *St. Christophers* or elsewhere in *America*, shall be in force as formerly, and shall be observed on both sides as heretofore, unless where they shall be found to be contrary to this present Treaty.

XXI.
