

BLAIR, WILLIAM M., *J.P.* (*Colchester.*)

Family originally from Blair Athol, Scot. B. in Onslow. Ed. there. M. 26 Jan. 1864, Harriet, dau. of Samuel James Blair. A farmer. Is a Justice of the Peace, and Lieut.-Col. commanding 78th Batt. Highlanders, Colchester, Hants and Pictou Militia. Chairman of the Agricultural Exhibition Committee, and Presdt. of the Onslow Agricultural Society. First returned to Parlt. at last g.e. A Liberal Conservative.—*Onslow, Co. Colchester, N.S.*

CAMPBELL, ALEXANDER, *J.P.* (*Inverness.*)

S. of Archibald Campbell, of the Argyll family or Clan, by Margaret McLean, grand-dau. of Major McLeod, whose distinguished services to his country are so well known. B. in the Isle of Skye, Inverness-shire, Scot., A.D. 1826. Emigrated to Cape Breton in 1830. Ed. in this country. M. in 1853 to Mary, dau. of John McLean, Esq., of this county (she d.); 2nd, Ella G. Grant, dau. of the late James Grant, Esq., of Pictou Co. Holds the office of senior Major of N.S. Militia. Is a Notary Public and Magistrate for the Co. First returned to Parlt. of Nova Scotia 1867, and retained seat until 1871. Again elected at last g.e. His opponent in 1867 was Horeham Blanchard, Esq., for some time the Atty.-Genl. of the Province. Liberal Conservative. Believes that our industries should be protected, and is hopeful of the N.P. being a decided improvement.—*Willow Bank, Strath-Lorn, Inverness Co., Cape Breton.*

CAMPBELL, DUNCAN J., *M.D., J.P.* (*Inverness.*)

S. of Samuel Campbell, Esq., of Margaree Forks, Inverness, N.S. B. there, 1845. Ed. at Harvard College, Cambridge, Mass. M. Feb. 1874, Elizabeth, dau. of Hon. Peter Smyth, M.L.C. Is a Coroner and Health Officer for Inverness. Apptd. Immigration Agent for N.S., 6 June 1875. First returned to Parlt. for present seat Sept. 1872, on resignation of sitting mem.; re-elected at g.e. 1874, and again at last g.e. A Liberal.—*Port Hood, N.S.*

FORD, LEANDER STARR. (*Queen's.*)

Descended from an old Loyalist family, from Mass., U.S., on his father's side; and from the McLeod clan, on his mother's. B. ed. and M. in Milton, Queen's Co., N.S. B. 23 Dec. 1836. M. a
