In testimony whereof, we have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent, and the Great Seal of *Canada* to be hereunto affixed: Witness Our Trusty and Well Beloved the Right Honorable Sir John Young, Baronet, one of our Most Honorable Privy Council, Knight Grand (ross of Our Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Knight Grand Cross of Our Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor General of Canada.

At Ottawa this twenty-sixth day of May in the year of Our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-nine, and in the Thirty-second year of Our Reign.
