An Act to amend the Act incorporating the Hamilton and Toronto Railway Company.

WHEREAS by an Act passed in the sixteenth year of Her Majesty's Preamble. VV Reign, intituled, "An Act to incorporate the Hamilton and Toronto "Railway Company" power is given to the said Company to make and complete a Railway from the Terminus of the Great Western Railroad at 5 the City of Hamilton to the City of Toronto upon such line as may be found most advantageous for the purpose, the said line being first approved by the Governor in Council: And whereas the said Company have located the said Railway in the manner pointed out in the said Act and the line so chosen has been approved by the Governor in Council: And whereas 10 the said Railway crosses the River Humber at a point near the mouth of the said river: And whereas the safety and convenience of Her Majesty's subjects will be greatly promoted by authorising the said Company to erect a fixed and permanent Bridge across the said river: Be it therefore enacted, &c., as follows:

I. It shall and may be lawful for the said Company to make and con- Crompany struct a fixed and permanent Bridge across the said River Humber or may make across any other River over which the said Railway may be carried: Pro-permanent vided always that the height of the said Bridge across the River Humber Rivers. shall not be less than ten feet clear above the ordinary level of the water

II. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
