authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, "An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's reign, intituled, 'An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec, in North America, and to make further Provision for the Government of the said Province," and by the authority of the same, that it shall and may be lawful for the Lieutenant-governor of this province, from time to time, by commission under the great Three commissioners seal of said province, to appoint three persons as commissioners, whose duty it shall be to inquire into the losses so sustained by Her Majesty's subjects during the late unnatural rebellion.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the said commissioners, Commissioners before they enter upon the execution of their office, shall take an oath before any one of Her fore entering on their Majesty's justices of the peace, which he is hereby authorized to administer, to the following office to take an oath, effect: "I, A. B., do swear that according to the best of my skill and knowledge I will &c. faithfully, impartially and truly execute the duty of commissioner for ascertaining the losses sustained by certain inhabitants of this province during the late unnatural rebellion. So help me God."

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that it shall and may be Authority given comlawful to and for the said commissioners, and they are hereby authorized and empowered and required to examine upon oath all persons whom the said commissioners shall think fit mine persons on oath, to examine touching all such matters and things as shall be necessary for the execution of the powers vested in the said commissioners by this Act; and all such persons are hereby directed and required personally to attend the said commissioners at such time and place as they shall appoint.

IV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the said commissioners Commissioners are hereby authorized to meet, and sit from time to time at such place or places as the Lieutenant-governor, or person administering the government of the province may direct, with or without adjournment, and to send their precept or precepts, under their hands and seals, for any person or persons whatsoever, and for such books, papers, writings, or records as they judge necessary for their information or the execution of the powers vested in the said commissioners by this Act; and the said commissioners are hereby authorized to appoint and employ a clerk and messenger.
