Mississauga transport system gets under way

A public transport syslinking Mississauga with Metro Toronto may get under way next September 1, provided legal difficulties don't stand in the way and the details

are sorted out soon The system as proposed in the Mississauga Transit Study last week re-

Town operation idea rejected

General committee turned down a suggestion from councillor Caye Killaby last week that town council operates its own bus service for Mississaugans.

Mrs. Killaby suggested the setting aside of \$200, 000 or \$300,000 a year to build up a fund to get it going.

Committee was told it would probably cost the town \$1 million for equipment to get started.

Engineer William Anderson, who headed the Mississauga Transit Study team, said it would be better for the town to provide the administrative side which would then involve the hiring of more personnel.

Councillors agreed with Mayor Robert Speck that
to take over such a service from scratch would cost

too much and decided it would be best to get it started via either the Toronto Transit Commission as the Study recommends or a local private firm. Committee decided it would be better to start the

public bus service on that basis and then take it over on a town operated basis a few years later.

Dean Henderson told committee it was best not to go directly into the bus business. He warned that other towns had tried it to little avail and wound up having it operated by private enterprise or a lease system.
