2	GALLOWAY ROCK CUT - completion of 0.2 miles of roadwork involving the excavation of 6500 cubic yards of sand rock	
3	PEMBINA HILL REVISION - completion of 1.7 miles of roadwork which includes the excavation of 8,400 cubic yards of common, solid and loose material	
4	MARLBORO - completion of 1.64 miles of roadwork, which includes the excavation of 16,000 cubic yards of loose rock and common material	
5	NORDEGG WEST TO JUNCTION OF JASPER-BANFF HIGHWAY - Road building project 35 miles which includes the clearing and grubbing of 320 acres, excavation of solid rock and loose rock and common excavation amounting to 500,000 cubic yards and necessary bridges, culverts and cribbing.	
6	CROWSNEST SUMMIT - completion of roadway 0.93 miles which includes clearing and grubbing of 3 acres and excavation of solid rock, loose rock, common excavation and rip rap amounting to 31,720 cubic yards
