
Ottawa 24th January, 1903.

Sir,

I beg to inform you that Mr C. Drinkwater, Secretary, and Assistant to the President of the C.P.R. Co. writes to day that the warehouse at Regina which was used by this Department for storing purposes is old and will fall to pieces, and that it has not been used by the Department for some time. He asks therefore whether the Department will abandon the building and surrender the lease.

I have to request that you will kindly report, at an early date, stating what you consider the building to be now worth. In this connection I may refer you to your letter of the 24th August 1899, No 21 G.
