With reference to your letter of the 24th instant,
xxx addressed to the Hon. the Superintendent General of
Indian Affairs, and also to previous correspondence, I beg
to say that I am directed
to inform you that Dr O.C. Edwards, the medical officer
will look after the medical needs of the Indians of the
Peigan Reserve, and furnish them, when necessary with
such drugs as they require. It is therefore not deemed
advisable to place any drugs in your care for distribution
to them, the matter being placed entirely in the hands
of the medical officer.
