Johnson, Barrister, etc., Bracebridge, has applied, in behalf of Mr. C. Munson, of Port Severn, who he states, is the owner of the mainland, to purchase the said island. I have to request you to be good enough to place a fair value on the said small island. It is not desired that you should go to any expense or that you should pay a special visit for the purpose. If it is necessary for you to see it please do so at the first convenient opportunity. I have also to request you to verify the fact that the island is situated opposite the property of Mr. Munson as shown on the plan enclosed. The little island contains approximately 0.09 acres.
