
Ottawa, 2nd December, 1919.

Sir,-

I am in receipt of your letter of the 27th ultimo, reporting with regard to the case of Peter Labrador, who suffers from tuberculosis and who has been isolated, and in reply I beg to say that the Department approves of the arrangements which you state have been made towards providing comfortable quarters for the invalid. The Department is prepared to pay accounts for the expense which you state was incurred to the amount of about \$12.00.

You should report as to the cost weekly, or monthly for fuel and provisions, and the Department will give you further instructions. You should be able to state the approximate cost. In the mean time necessary food and fuel may be supplied.
