the Houses of Parliament of them Treaties does not imply To this end, their immediate ratification by Ganada. Two steps must thereafter be taken, First, a submission must be made with the approval of the Governor in Council to the King, asking for the execution by His Majesty of Instruments of Ratification. Second, the Instruments of Ratification signed by the King must be deposited as provided for in the Treaties.

provide that in the first instance the entry into force of the Treaties will depend upon the deposit of Instruments of Ratification by certain of the Great Powers which are members of the Gouncil of Foreign Ministers. In the case of Italy, these are the Union of Soviet Socialist Republies, the United Kingdom, the United States of America, and France. In the case of Hungary and Roumania the deposit of Instruments of Ratification by the Soviet Union, the United Kingdom, and the United States of America is required. The Treaty of Peace with Finland will cater into force when the Soviet Union and United Kingdom have deposited their Instruments of Ratification. The
