aspect -

Canada has from early colonial times been the "laboratory of the Empire";

A concession granted to Canada was thereafter extended to other principal colonies;

Thus while the struggle which finally emed in the freedom we enjoy today was largely confined to what is now Canada, the scope of its effects was Empire-wide;

The central point in that long period of development was the series of events which culminated in the outbreak, the centennary of which is being observed in Canada this year;

## (2) Centennary of Struggle of 1837:

Year 1837, in real sense, forms political water-shed in

Canada and, hence, of Empire as a whole 
Prior to that time, a more or less consistent

deterioration discernible in administra
tion of British North American colonies;

After 1837, there was, on the whole, steady progress

towards the complete freedom which charac
terizes Canada's position in Empire of today;
