

SUMMARY OF EVIDENCE

Summary of Evidence in the case of B-29653 Spr GREER, Stanley, Arthur, Royal Canadian Engineers, on the strength of No. 1 Canadian Engineer Reinforcement Unit, a soldier of the Canadian Army (Overseas).

By direction of the Commanding Officer the summary of evidence is taken on oath.

FIRST WITNESS

For the prosecution B-28724 Sgt EVELEIGH, H.P., on strength of No. 1 Canadian Engineer Reinforcement Unit, a soldier of the Canadian Army (Overseas) having been duly sworn, states as follows:-

B-28724 Sgt EVELEIGH, H.P., in charge of draft section "H" Coy. I was present at 0800 hrs Sept 28/43 when Major MAGGS, O.C., of "H" Coy. called the draft section roll and B-29653 Spr GREER, Stanley, Arthur, was present, and answered his name, and was warned by Major MAGGS, that failing to be present on the final draft parade at 0600 hrs Sep 30/43 through being A.W.L. would leave himself liable for a charge of desertion. I was also present at 0600 hrs Sep 30/43 when Major MAGGS, called the final draft roll, and B-29653 Spr GREER, Stanley, Arthur, did not answer his name and through being absent without leave failed to proceed with the draft from No. 1 C.E.R.U.

The accused declines to cross examine the witness.
