

• 30 inches from a water-course which heads from the West and passes through the Shackson Reserve. (20<sup>th</sup> Aug. 1875.)

The following are the Reserves for the Nicomen Indians, all lying within the 20 mile Belt.

No. 1. Nicomen Reserve - On the Left Bank of the Thompson River about 5 chains South of the mouth of the Nicomen River and near the 28 mile post from Yale.

No. 2. • Finialka - on the Nicomen River immediately above the Water Fall about 1/2 mile from its junction with the Thompson River.

No. 3. • Jackum - On the Left Bank of the Thompson River North of the Jackum Creek and near the 70 mile post from Yale.

No. 4. • Achpoota - On the Right Bank of the Thompson River, 20 chains below the Jackum Reserve.

No. 5. • Cluskum - On the Right Bank of the Thompson River, about 1/2 mile above the junction of the Jackum stream.

No. 6. • Little. On the Right Bank of the Thompson River at the junction of the Little stream.

No. 7. • Brookhouse on the Right Bank of the Thompson River opposite the 67 mile post from Yale.

No. 8. • Unpukpukumat - On the River Bank of the Thompson River nearly opposite the 68 mile post from Yale.
