

* 30 inches from a water-course which heads from the West and passes through the Sackam Reserve. (20th Aug. 1875.)

The following are the Reserves for the Nicomin Indians, all lying within the 20 mile Belt:
No. 1. Nicomin Reserve - on the Left Bank of the Thompson River about 5 chains South of the mouth of the Nicomin River and near the 68 mile post from Vale.

No. 2. ~~Opinake~~ Opinake - on the Nicomin River immediately above the Water Fall about 1/2 mile from its junction with the Thompson River.

No. 3. Sackam - On the Left Bank of the Thompson River North of the Sackam Creek and near the 70 mile post from Vale.

No. 4. Ashpote - On the Right Bank of the Thompson River, 20 chains below the Sackam Reserve.

No. 5. Kuskomit - On the Right Bank of the Thompson River about 1/2 mile above the junction of the Sackam Stream.

No. 6. Ceticin - On the Right Bank of the Thompson River at the junction of the Ceticin stream.

No. 7. Ashkosh - On the Right Bank of the Thompson River opposite the 67 mile post from Vale.

No. 8. Anup-pulquatam - On the Right Bank of the Thompson River nearly opposite the 68 mile post from Vale.
