

THE COAL RESOURCES OF RHODESIA

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(With one map in the text)

THE coal-bearing beds of Rhodesia belong to the Karroo formation, which is widely distributed in the low-lying basins of the Limpopo and Zambesi rivers and their affluents. As shown on the accompanying map the largest area of Karroo rocks occupies the middle course of the Zambesi and stretches southward to the Zambesi-Limpopo watershed, several outliers being found on the divide itself. The outcrops of the coal-bearing beds, so far as their extent is known at present, are represented on the map in black, the rest of the Karroo formation by ruling.
