This Parish is partly situated in the Electoral Division of St François Xavier, West, and partly in St François Xavier, East. Was established in 1824 by Rev. M. François Boucher. The Rev. Sisters of Charity founded a Public School in 1850 which has continued since. Is the seat of the County Court for Marquette, East. This place is also commonly called "Prairie du Cheval Blanc" (White Horse Plain). A Church (R. C.), several very good schools, stores, &c., are founded here.
