**BRIDGEBURG, ONT.**—Palmer Lodge A. F. & A. M. have purchased a lot on which to erect a brick building to cost about \$7,000, 3-stories, with stores on the first floor and offices and lodge rooms above.

**WALKERTON, ONT.**—Alex Anderson, Reeve Township of Brant, will receive tenders up to 29th inst. for construction of two cement abutments and steel superstructure for a 140-foot span bridge over the Saugeen river.

**EDMONTON, N. W. T.**—The Edmonton and Stave Lake Railway Co. have filed in the land office here plans for a railway north from Edmonton for a distance of 50 miles. The plans are signed by William Mackenzie, Toronto, as president.

**VANCOUVER, B.C.**—A proposition to extend the city hall is under consideration.—The municipality of North Vancouver is about to construct a waterworks system, at a cost of \$50,000. The supply of water will be secured from Lynn Creek, across which a dam will be constructed.

**NIAGARA FALLS, ONT.**—Tenders have just been taken by the corporation for construction of Section 15 of the sewerage system.—The by-law to provide \$16,000 for sewer construction will be voted on July 11.—William Nichols, architect, wants tenders by 27th inst. for building a two-storey brick block for James Barry.

**DALHOUSIE, N.B.**—The Dominion Government is asking for tenders up to July 8th for construction of a deep water wharf here. Cheque for \$4,500 to accompany each tender. Plans at offices of E.T.P. Shewen, resident engineer, St. John, N.B., and Geoffrey Stead, Chatham, N.B., and on application to the Postmaster here.

**SEAFORTH, ONT.**—Huron and Perth Councils will likely join in building a steel bridge, with concrete abutments, on the boundary of Grey and Elma.—Tenders will be asked by the County Council for the erection of a bridge across Sauble river, on the town line between the townships of Hay and Stephen.

**OWEN SOUND, ONT.**—A committee of the County Council has recommended that a new bridge be built on the town line between Holland and Sydenham. Engineer McDowall will report as to the cost of building bridges at Strathavon and the Big Head river on the town line between St. Vincent and Sydenham.

**THAMESVILLE, ONT.**—By-laws to borrow \$13,700 for waterworks system and \$6,000 for granolithic sidewalks will be submitted to the ratepayers July 11th.—The report on waterworks system submitted by John Galt, C.E., Toronto, provides \$4,500 for mains, \$1,200 for basin, \$4,500 for elevated storage tank, \$1,700 for pump, etc., and \$700 for hydrants and valves.

**ST. JOHN, N. B.**—McKean & Dunn, architects, are this week taking tenders on erection of brick building for vestry of the Church of St. John the Baptist on Broad street.—It is the intention to build a three-storey addition to St. Luke's church.—W. M. Mitchell, architect, is preparing plans for a floating hotel to be built by George Whittaker, of Mill street, and others; estimated cost, \$25,000.—D. Pottinger, manager Intercolonial Railway, Moncton, desires tenders by 27th inst. for construction of brick office and store building in this city.—Engineer Barbour will shortly present his report on a water supply.

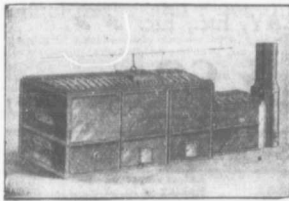
