

## PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Major General Sir John Harvey, Knight Commander of the Most Honourable Military Order of the Bath, Knight Commander of the Royal Hanoverian Guelphic Order, Governor and Commander in Chief in and over the Island of Newfoundland and its Dependencies, &c. &c.

HEREAS the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of this Island stands Frerogued until Wednesday the Eleventh Day of June inst: And Whereas I think it fit further to Prorogue the said General Assembly until Wednesday the 13th Day of August next.

I do, therefore, by this my proclamation, Prorogue the said GENERAL ASSEMBLY until Wednesday the 13th day of August next: And all Persons concerned are required and commanded to take due notice and govern themselves accordingly.

Given under my Hand and Seal, at the Government House, at St. John's, the Fourth Day of June, 1845, in the 8th Year of Her Majesty's Reign
