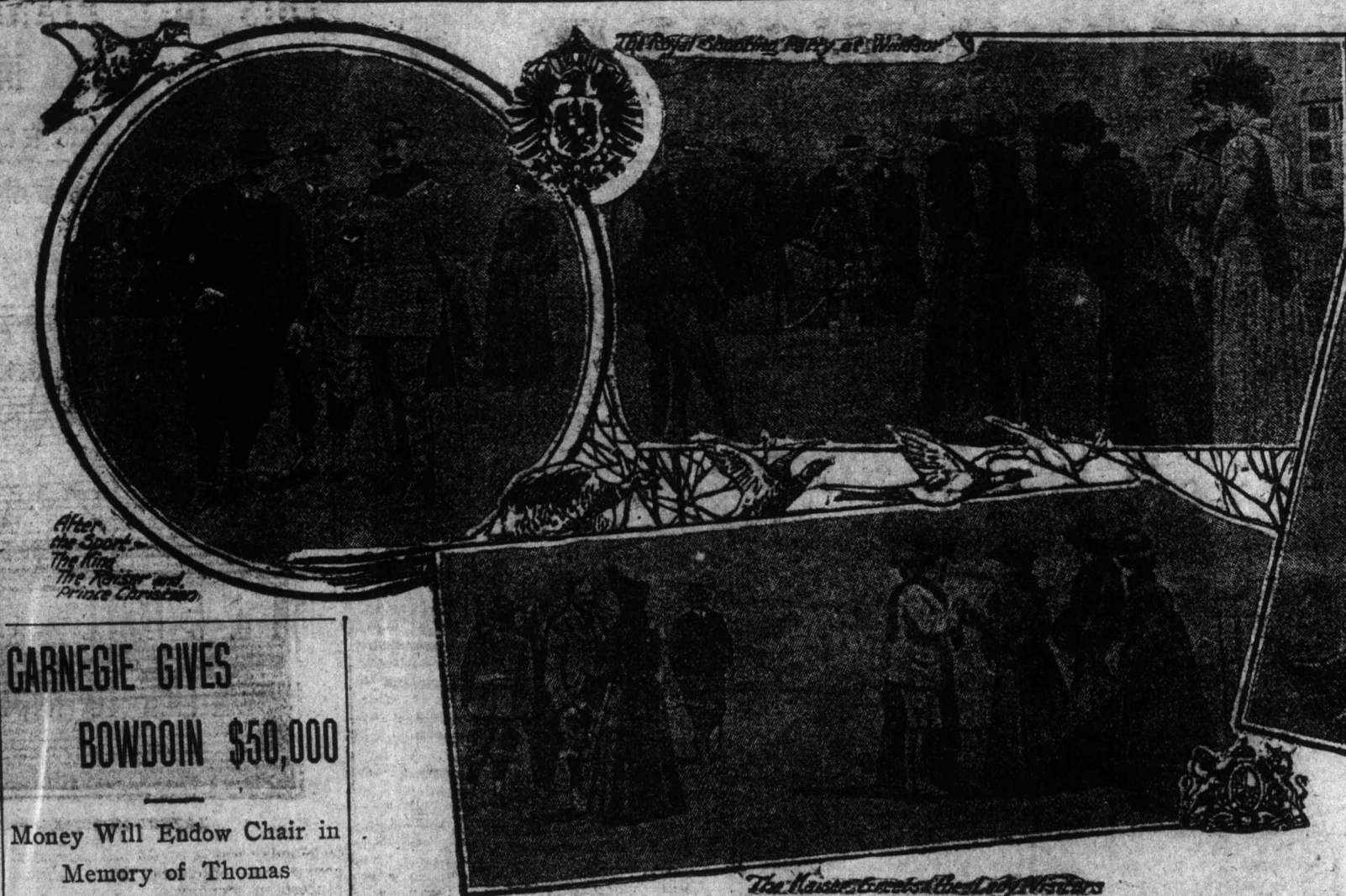

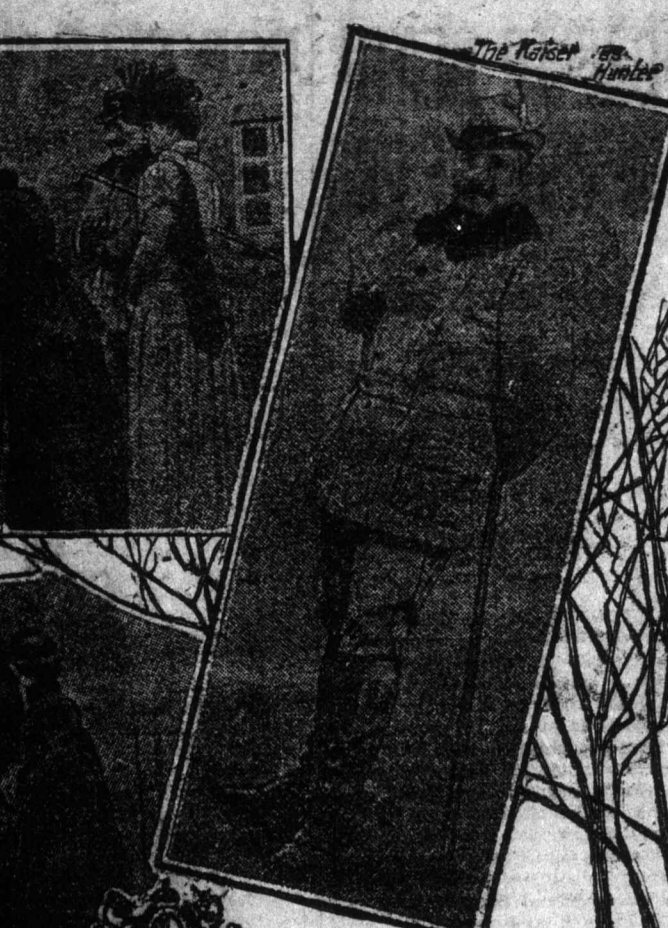

BUOY WAS NOT IN PLACE

Kildona Inquiry in Halifax Saturday

Held at Government's Order —Capt. Roberts Received Word by Wireless

HALIFAX, N. S., Dec. 22.—The commissioner and nautical assessors in the steamer Mount Temple investigation were also instructed from Ottawa to investigate the wreck of the steamer Kildona.

The agents of the owners of the ship, Campbell & Co., were notified, and it was ascertained on Saturday that Captain Roberts and the officers and crew of the Kildona had taken passage for England at St. John, and were on the Allan liner Corcoran.
