NOT SINCE 'BLACK FRIDAY' OF 1869 HAS IT OCCURRED. New York Stock Exchange Closed Its Doors Following a Meeting of Morgan and Others.

[By Special Wire to the Courier] NEW YORK, July 31.—The New York Stock Exchange was closed today on account of the European situation. The Consolidated Stock Exchange and New York curb market also ceased business. This was followed immediately by announcements of the closing of exchanges in the other chief cities throughout the country.

Some factories have closed down for stock-taking, and others were contemplating doing so. Conditions in all industries compared very unfavorably with last year, and preceding years. Quite a large number of men were working away from the city, noticeably bricklayers and masons and painters.
