Spraying Fruit Trees.

A great deal has been written and expounded by institute speakers from platforms about the spraying of fruit trees.

In the majority of cases, upon the most important part the least has been said, i. e., the time the spray should be put on.

It has been said that you can prune a tree whenever the saw is sharp. With spraying it is just the opposite, more particularly the first spraying.

To those who may think the buds are too far advanced, we feel safe in saying that there will be no danger at all this week and probably the next following, unless the buds expand faster than ordinary seasons.

While one may be afraid of burning the tips of the showing leaves with the strong Lime-Sulphur solution of 4 gals. to 40 experience has proven in the past that there is practically little or no danger of doing so even when the leaves are showing three quarters of an inch or more.

The advantage of spraying just now with the strong solution and Arsenate of Lead added is on account of placing a thin coating of poison over the outside of the bud so that when the bud moth undertakes to eat his way into the heart of the bud he is poisoned.

We understand and appreciate the first concern of the American people in determining the cause of the gigantic disaster and in urging such legislation as may be necessary to safeguard sea travel in future.
