Oats will be sold for \$1.32 per bushel in bulk in car lots, or \$1.33 in bags in car lots laid down.

Wheat will be sold for \$3. per bushel in bags, car lots, or f.o.b. distributing points for smaller orders.

Local freights will be paid by purchaser.

County Councillors and Agricultural Societies should place car lot orders immediately, stating destination for cars.

Delivery not guaranteed unless orders placed within three weeks, because of transportation difficulties.
