### NOTE AND COMMENT.

The British warship is always on the job whenever there is trouble brewing. The pupils of the American high school near Constantinople were safe on board a warship that flies the Union Jack before the ships of their own nation had received word to sail.

It is possible that Michigan may see a vote for state wide prohibition this year. The recent granting of the franchise to the women of the State has given special encouragement to the temperance forces and they think they can win.

Among the curious suggestions of amendments to existing laws was one to regulate the length of ladies' skirts. Another was to prohibit the enclosure of pictures, flags or other things in boxes of cigarettes, which are calculated to stimulate the sale. These suggestions have been recent ly made at Ottawa.

While it is stated that less than half a hundred cases of divorce will come before ihe Canadian Parliament this session, it must not be forgotten that many Canadians settle their matrimonial troubles on the other side of the line. Between 1887 and 1906 there were 455 Canadian cases a year in the United States, or an aggregate of 8,645.

In that way it was found that the milk-producing value of the herd was increased by two quarts each cow per day—a total of one hundred and forty quarts.

A new movement has been started to keep the boy on the farm. It has been decided by the Ontario Agricultural Department to hold fall fairs in connection with the public schools in all parts of the province, and those who have been endeavoring to widen the appeal of the farm to the younger generation feel convinced that the desired results will be achieved by the means now proposed. The idea was originated this year when twelve fairs were held by school children in different parts of Ontario.
