BREAD MAKING.—In making bread a favourite plan with some is, scald the flour for springe, either with clear, boiling water, or with that in which potatoes have been loiled, and add two or three mealy mashed or grated potatoes to it. But there is some langer of scalding the yeast, too, in which case the bread will not rise at all, or rise slowly and imperfectly. When the flour is scalded, either let it stand until cool enough, or only put on boiling water enough to make it into a stiff dough, and gradually thin with cold water until cool enough. Try it with the finger after stirring up well from the bottom, and do not add yeast until the batter is not above blood heat.
