# Montreal Stock Market.

MARKET NARROW, BUT STEADY -GAS, WAR EAGLE, AND RAILS THE MOST ACTIVE-PACIFIC STEADY.

Sales at morning Board only amounted to about 2000 shares of Miscellaneous and 17,700 War Eagle. Miscellaneous and 17,700 War Eagle. There is but one opinion about the market amongst outsiders. Some of the older Wiseacres and more conservative brokers shake their heads and regard with doubts the manipulations of operators. Their opinions to clients suggest hesitation as to what course to follow. The heavy advances in Montreal St. Ry., Gas, and Eagle, make them shy of these stocks. There are some, however, left in which their is room for a much higher range of prices than at present rule. Chief amongst these may be mentioned Pacific and Toronto Ry. Duluths might be also mentioned in this category, but nothing but speculation can cause much of a rise in these shares. in these shares.

Pacific was steady and Montreal Street stronger. Gas sold to the ex-tent of 400 shares at a slightly higher ange than yesterday.

Toronto Rails was again the leader and over 1000 shares changed hands at strong prices. The late advance was fully maintained. War Eagle was active and in demand, selling up to 299 and closing strong. Royal Electric steady. Dominion Coal Pfd sold at 114 ex div. Other shares unchanged.
