has not yet been enough snow for sleighing, there have been no storms, and there has been little or no zero weather, and this is almost equally the case over the whole extent of country mentioned. Those who know that a difference of fifty miles of latitude in Ontario makes such a serious difference of climate as it does there, cannot but believe that the 200 miles that the Saskatchewan is north of the railway line must give it a much more severe climate in winter, and more uncertain in summer, than the region along the line is possessed of, while the fact is that the difference, if any, is as often in favor of the Saskatchewan as against it. What the Saskatchewan loses on occount of higher latitude it gains on account of lower elevation and more shelter, and in many cases the gain is greater than the loss.
