The Governments signatory to the present Protocol,

Considering that, unless prolonged in force by action taken for that purposed by the interested Governments, the International Sanitary Convention Aerial Navigation, 1944, Modifying the International Sanitary Convention Aerial Navigation of April 12, 1933, will expire on July 15, 1946, the expiration of eighteen months from the data. of eighteen months from the date on which the said 1944 Convention entered into force; and

Have appointed their respective Plenipotentiaries who, having deposited their full powers, found in good and proper form, have agreed as follows:
