World Health Organization Nomenclature Regulations, 1967<sup>1</sup>

Adopted at Geneva, **May 22, 1967**

Entered into force for Canada January 1, 1969

The World Health Organization Regulations No. 1 of July 24, 1948 (TIAS 3482) regarding nomenclature remain in force as regards parties to them which are not yet parties to the 1967 regulations.
