With luck one can find paid employment such as temporary secretarial work, principally in the American Embassy. Salaries range from \$4,000 to \$10,000 per year for a secretary.

Volunteer work is welcome everywhere. The Institut Marchoux, for example, readily accepts help from foreigners.

There are very few opportunities for spouses to engage in gainful employment in Rabat.

In addition to the positions of nurse and Community Co-ordinator, CIDA occasionally offers contracts to spouses with the requisite qualifications.

It is possible to find employment as a teacher or substitute teacher at the American school, and at the schools of the French mission as a supervisor or substitute. Some spouses give private language lessons at home, or instruction in calligraphy, sewing, etc.

Despite the recent Reciprocal Employment Agreement, good jobs are still hard to find.
