

Clause 20

Strike out lines 12 to 17 both inclusive, on page 10 and substitute the following therefor:

'any amount so demanded, the approved insurer with whom the insurance referred to in subsection (1) was maintained is liable to Her Majesty for that amount.'

Clause 24

Strike out line 24 on page 12 and substitute the following therefor:

'Commission or by three or more members.'

Strike out line 29 on page 12 and substitute the following therefor:

'than two members of the Commission, a'

Strike out line 35 on page 12 and substitute the following therefor:

'by more than two members of a'

Strike out in line 38 on page 12, the word "and".

Strike out lines 39 to 41, both inclusive, on page 12.

Pursuant to Standing Order 58, Mr. Alexander, seconded by Mr. Forrestall, moved,—That this House declares that the Government must, in view of the disastrous decline in residential housing construction, announce before the summer recess new measures to stimulate a significant expansion in the number of housing units being built, to reduce the total cost of individual homes for middle and low income Canadians, and to reduce or eliminate unemployment in the construction trades.
