

be 2,172,000, less the 26·8 per cent, or 1,590,000. So that on this basis the unemployed in the dominion at the present time number 1,025,400. In the face of this, and in view of the amount we have spent this year in direct relief, the government is placing a limit of \$20,000,000 to meet such a situation—a situation which, as I have pointed out before, is constantly getting worse because the provincial governments and the municipalities are less able to take care of it than they were a year ago.

I am sorry I cannot give my support to the government in passing this measure as it stands at the present time, with a limit set to the amount which may be appropriated for direct relief.

Mr. BROWN: Has the minister any statement to make in reply to my question?

Mr. SPEAKER: The minister, on the third reading, has no right of reply.
