Adjournment deferred.

(4) When it is provided in any standing order that the business under consideration at the ordinary time of adjournment be forthwith disposed of or concluded, Mr. Speaker shall not adjourn the House until the specified proceedings be completed.

Business interrupted. 7. At the ordinary time of adjournment of the House, unless otherwise provided, the proceedings shall be interrupted and the business under consideration at the termination of the sitting shall stand over until the next sitting day when it will be taken up at the same stage where its progress was interrupted.

Divisions.

8. When members have been called in, preparatory to a division, no further debate is to be permitted.

Five members to demand.

Speaker's casting vote. 9. Upon a division, the yeas and nays shall not be entered upon the minutes, unless demanded by five members.

10. Mr. Speaker shall not take part in any debate before the House. In case of an equality of voices, Mr.
