By the Honorable Mr. *Cornwall* :—

1 April 30—That an humble Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General, praying that His Excellency will be pleased to cause to be laid before this House, copies of any correspondence which has taken place since 1871 between the Home Government and the Government of the Dominion of *Canada* on the question of the maintenance of the Naval Station at *Esquimault, British Columbia*, and generally as to the defence of the *Pacific* coast, and the interests therein of *Canada*.
