many are present the animal loses condition, gets potbellied, has a rough coat, capricious appetite, shows a tendency to eat dirt, with occasionally a colic or diarrhora, and presence of worms in the dung. The riddance

of a horse of these parasites is not very difficult if a thorough effort is made to dislodge them, in order to get the best effects the animal should be starved before giving the drugs, which may be as follows:

Tartar emetic	1 2	drachm,
Copperas	1 2	drachm,
