

killed several. In return for many acts of cruelty, the priest and the rest of the prisoners were put to death, and scalp'd by our rangers.

20th, The troops (marines excepted) embark'd from St. Anthony's in the night, under General Murray, and row'd up under cover of it, to the village of Chambeau: at the same time, a feint was made to land at Point Tremble, in order to deceive the enemy.

21st, At break of day our troops landed at Chambeau, 18 leagues above Quebec, on the north shore, without any opposition: they destroy'd a grand magazine of the enemy's regulars, the effects of the people of Quebec, a great quantity of powder, some plate and specie, which was all destroy'd by fire. At noon, having completed their design, embark'd without
loss,
