Access to the summit of the towers by 25 stair-cases, forming 285 steps.

The doors are 17 feet by 10 feet wide.

The windows, 36 feet by 10 feet.

The grand window in rear of the altar is 60 feet by 33 feet.

The number of pews in the lower part and galleries is 1363.

The building can contain 15,000 persons.

The exterior is of hewn stone, erected at the cost of £80,000 currency.

The building was commenced in 1823, and finished in 1829    Towers finished in 1842.
