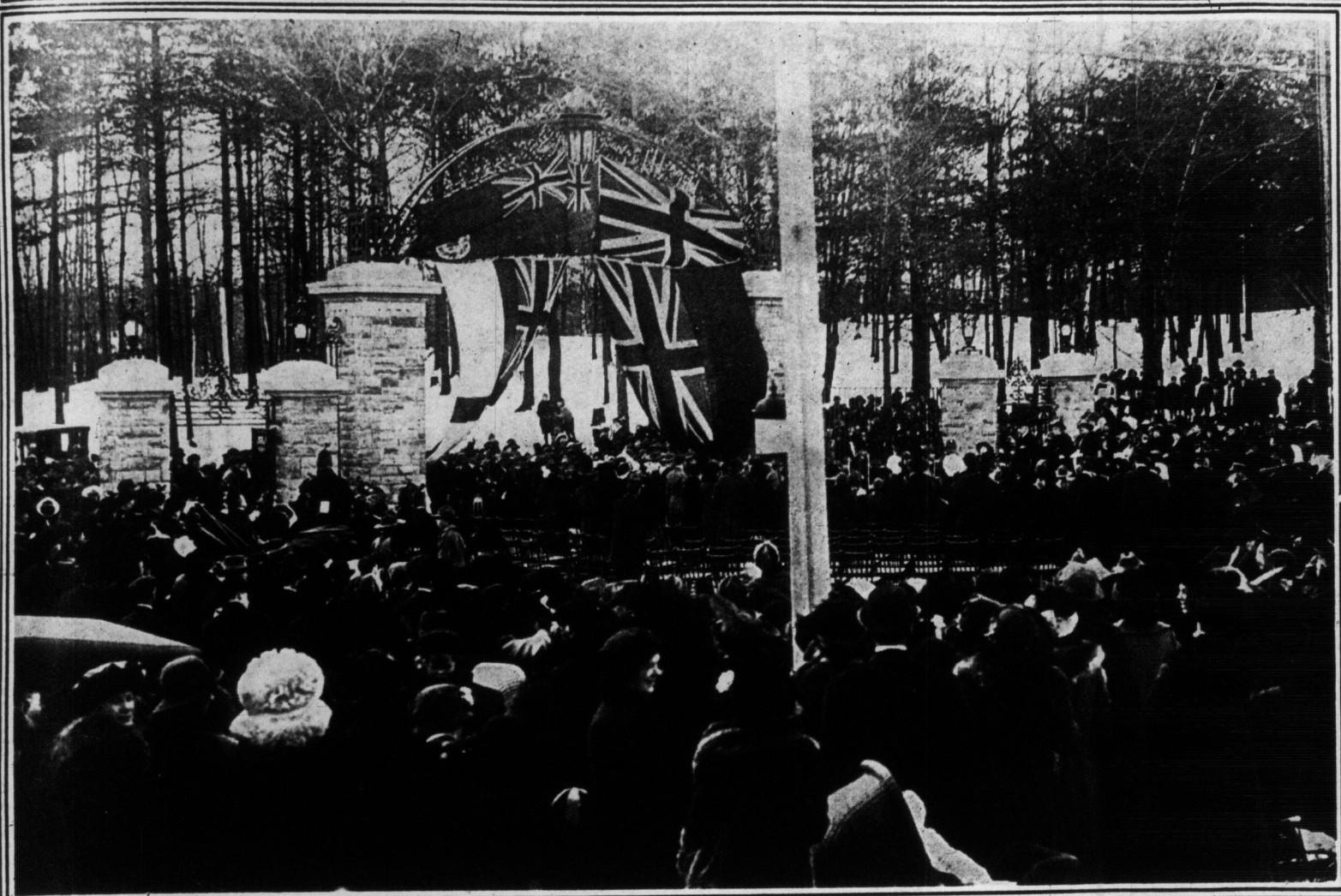


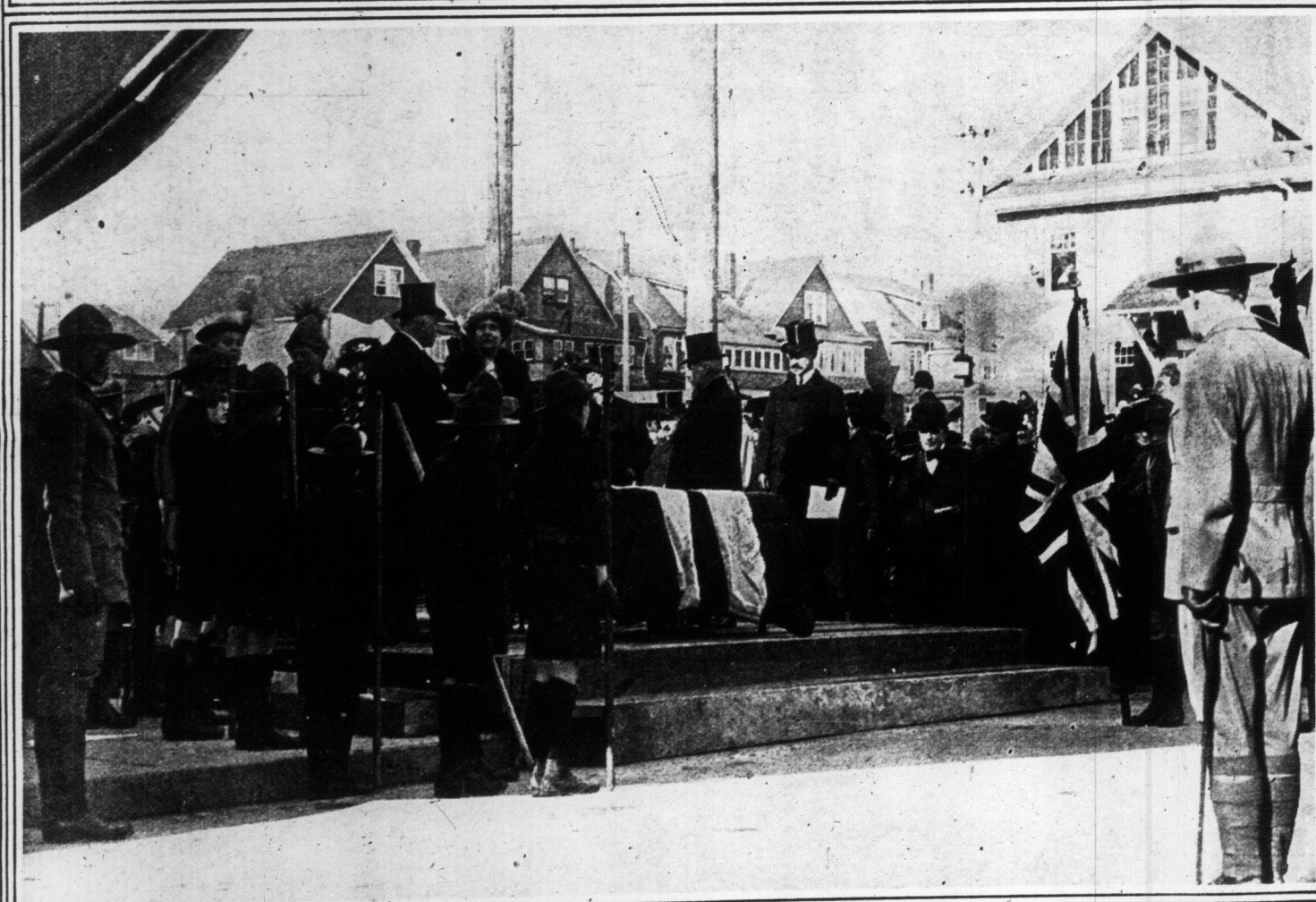
GOVERNOR-GENERAL'S BUSY DAY--SPRING ALONG THE BAY

Waiting at the boy scouts' headquarters for the chief scout, the Duke of Connaught.



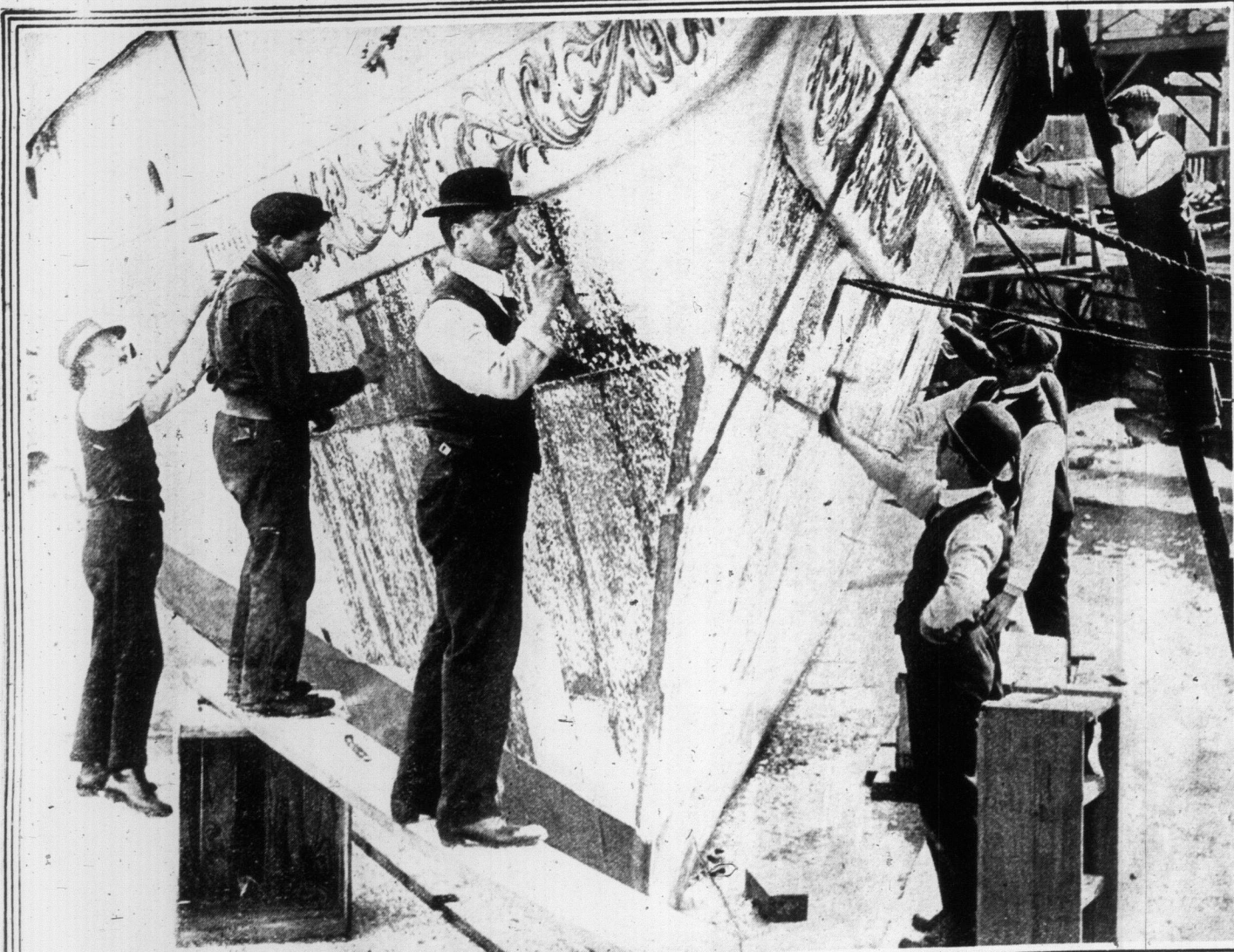
His Royal Highness performing ceremony dedicating High Park Boulevard Memorial Entrance, erected by Daughters of Empire.
