CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

OF THE

ONTARIO RIFLE ASSOCIATION.

CONSTITUTION.

- 1. That this Association be denominated "The Ontario Rifle Association."
- 2. That the membership fee be \$1 per annum, and that all memberships be paid for at that rate.
- 3. Donors of \$20 at one time to the funds of the Association, or of a prize of not less than \$40, to be competed for at the annual prize meeting, shall be entitled to be enrolled as life members of the Association.
- 4. That Associations shall pay \$5 per annum for the privilege of affiliation, irrespective of membership or individual entrance fees, entitling an Association to a badge, and to compete in the Affiliated Association Match for Team Prizes only.
 - 5. There shall be a Patron and Vice-Patrons named by the Council.

The Lieut.-Governor of the Province of Ontario, for the time being, shall be respectfully requested to become "Patron."

- 6. There shall be a President.
- 7. There shall be four Vice-Presidents,—one for each Military District.
- 8. There shall be a Council, composed as follows:
 - 1st. Four members from each of the Military Districts, who shall be elected primarily at this meeting, and hereafter at the annual meeting.
 - 2nd. The ex-Presidents of the Association.
 - 3rd. The District Deputy Adjutants-General of Militia.
 - 4th. The Brigade Majors.
 - 5th. The Presidents of local affiliated Associations and Clubs, being members of the Association.
