A CONGO QUESTION IS  PLACED BEFORE MINISTER  Paris, Sept. 22 — The companies doing business in the French Congo have presented enquiries to the minister of the colonies as to what indemnities the government would offer them in event that the territories within which they were operating were transferred to Germany as an outcoine of the Moroccan negotiations. The minister of the colonies, M. Lebrun replying, stated that Germany would protect all rights and would carry out the engagements which had been made with France.
