

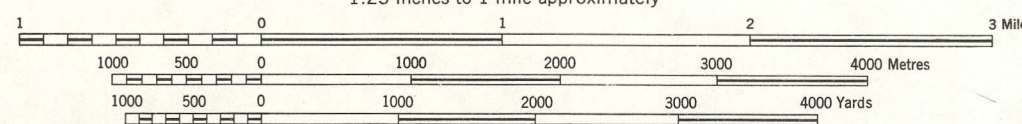


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MAGNETIC DECLINATION 27'15" WEST AT CENTRE OF MAP 1958 Annual magnetic change 2'30" easterly
