Neudenburg, 6. Dez. 1922. An meine Wohlthäter!

Der hochw. Herr P. Windichnegl hat in einer Notiz im St. Peters Bote (auch für einen armen deutschen Theologen um eine kleine Gabe gebeten. Wie herrlichen Beweise eines Eiferers hat er mir ein großes Geschenk (31 Dollars) geschickt. Wie ich nun dem guten Peter den Rest für seine gute Vermittlung danke, so möchte ich auch auf alle meine edlen Wohlthäter ein würdevolles, heiliges „Benedictus“ aussprechen. Ihr habt durch eure Gabe meiner 16. Winter, die als Witwe nur noch mehrere unermüdete Kinder zu sorgen hat, eine schwere Sorge vom Herzen genommen und mir weitergeholfen, mein heiliges Ziel zu erreichen. Möge der Heiland, der nach seinen eigenen Worten selbst Euer Schuldner geworden ist, wenn er sagt: „Alles, was ihr dem geringsten meiner Brüder getan, das habt ihr mir getan“, möge Er Euch Euren Eifer tausendfach belohnen!

Recht es mir nicht abel, wenn ich heute schon wieder eine Bitte stelle an Euch: Schaut, ich bin ein armer, schwacher Mensch, der es nicht wert ist, Briefe zu werden zu dürfen, der sich aber doch mit der ganzen Macht seines jugendlichen Herzens nach dem Dienst im Heiligtum sehnt. Darum bitte ich Euch: wendet in den deutschen Theologen, den ich in so hochherziger Weise durch eure Gabe zum Ziel erreichen ließ, betet für ihn um die Gnade, daß er ein guter Priester werden kann.

Nach im Jahre dieses Jahres soll mir die große Gnade zuteil werden, daß ich mich durch die höheren Weihen (Subdiakon und Diakon) ganz und unabweislich dem Heiland weihen darf. Betet, daß ich diesen wichtigen Schritt, diese Lebenswende, in würdiger, Gott wohlgefälliger Weise vornehmen kann. Betet für mich, daß ich mich der Wohlthäter, die mir Gott durch eure Güte erwiesen, würdig erweise, und daß ich sie Euch immergemäßen vergelten kann, indem ich Euch einst alle in mein Erntedankfest einlade. Wie dahin werde ich auch zu meiner Wohlthäter im Gebete vergehen. Wenn ich mein Ziel erreicht habe — es wird dies, so Gott will, im Juni 1924 der Fall sein — werde ich es Euch durch Hochw. Herrn P. Windichnegl wissen lassen.
