# First Annual Report of the Women's Mission Society.

This society was organized in September, 1882. There are 28 members, 3 of whom are honorary. The Society meets on the first Tuesday of each month, when reports of the various mission schemes are read.

In connection with this society a "children's meeting" is held every Saturday afternoon, the children sewing or doing some useful work while some one of the ladies reads interesting accounts of work being done in the mission field.

"Mite boxes" were placed in the hands of many of the children, and in December a "Sale of Work" was held. The Society is pleased to report that the proceeds from these two sources amount to \$78.81. Of this \$75 was voted to the General Mission Fund of the church, but it is the intention of the Society to endeavor to support a native missionary in Formosa.
