On a Memorandum dated 7th February, 1902, from
the Superintendent General of Indians Affairs stating
that a resolution has been passed by the Burnt Church
Band of Indians in Council approving of an expenditure
up to \$1,000.00 being made from their Capital on the
construction of a combined school and Council House

on their reserve in the County of Northumberland,
Province of New Brunswick; and the Indian Agent has
reported in favour of such expenditure being made.

The Minister recommends, as the work when com-
pleted will be in the nature of a permanent improve-
ment and properly represent Capital, that, under Section
139 of The Indian Act, as added thereto by Sec. 11 of
Chap. 32; Vic. 57-58, authority be given for the expend-
iture thereon of the above mentioned sum from the
Capital at the credit of the Burnt Church Band, which
amounts to \$ 2,760.00

The Committee submit the same for His Excellen-
cy's approval.
