Brouse moved, seconded by Dr. Campbell,—That after several years of practical working of our present Medical Bill, this Council is of the unanimous opinion that more stringent penal clauses should be obtained, whereby uneducated and unlicensed men may be proven ed from practising as physicians, or dispensing medicines in the Province of Ontario. That this Council regrets that the penal clause of our Bill, as originally drafted, was struck out. Therefore each member pledges himself to use all his influence among his confrères throughout the Province, to have the necessary penal clauses incorporated in our Medical Bill, for the better security of all parties interested.
