TEA DRINKING IN RUSSIA. St. Petersburg, Feb. 11.—Everybody drinks tea in this country. It is the national beverage. The noble has it in his palace. The driver of the droshki and the artisan it have in the humble tea sheds erected in the streets. I have seen poor fellows, unable to afford the extra cost of having his cup of tea sweetened, take a lump of sugar out of his pocket and touch his tongue with it before each sip. I have seen roblemans and women, with no more gusto, taking their tea out of Sevres cups that cost a peasant's life earnings. It can then be imagined that the action of the Minister of Finance in deciding to increase the duty on tea is received with anything but agreeable sensations. The increase is eighteen copecks (thirteen cents) a pound, levied on all tea brought into the country by sea. The worst of the tax is that it falls exclusively on the poor, as the richer classes use tea that has been brought overland. The tax is a cruel one.
